Approximate numbers of workers planned for a new factory coming to Fort Worth, TX area to build the next generation Motorola smart phones. Cell phone maker Motorola Mobility is now owned by Google. Nearly all cell phone assembly has long left the US for Asia (some postponement work remains), so this is an interesting move, and will be the first US-built smart phone. Having lost much market share in recent years, Motorola hopes for a comeback through a new Moto X line family of phones that will be made at the Texas plant (which will be operated by Flextronics), though the company acknowledges it will be reliant on some parts that will need to be brought in from Asia.
